

# 2011 Local Long Distance Races

## Notice of Series

### 1) Eligibility

- a) Entered boats competing in any of the eligible races
- b) Separate entry and registration into each eligible race (regatta) is required
- c) Full compliance with the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions of those regattas

### 2) Eligible Races

Each race must be entered and paid separately via their respective online registration noted above.

**Please pay special attention to locate and enter only the Long Distance event of each regatta.**

### 3) Scoring

- a) No throw outs, all entered races shall be scored.
- b) All boats entered in any two of the eligible races shall automatically be scored in the series
- c) The boat with the lowest combined score wins.

### 4) Prizes

- a) 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place Overall Awards shall be presented at the CYC Offshore Awards Dinner on Friday October 21, 2011

As a courtesy, we ask that each yacht notify us via email at [racecoordinator@chicagoyachtclub.org](mailto:racecoordinator@chicagoyachtclub.org) of their intent to compete in the Long Distance Series (no separate entry form or payment for the overall series is required). Please include the Skipper/Owners name, the boat name, sail number and contact information.

Please Note: Membership at US Sailing (the national organizing body of sailing) is highly encouraged and may be required by participants of the regattas – please see their website [www.ussailing.org](http://www.ussailing.org) for information about membership.

Races will be scored using the US Sailing ORR handicap system, please contact them directly (401-683-0800, option #4) to request an application – for stock boats the process should be simple and painless.
